### 7. TMEA Audition Policies: Updates

Updates - electronic devices may not be used to communicate, photographing, or streaming record any student or yourself, will result in disqualification

Cannot use headphones, earphones, unless hearing loss purposes

Update - Erratum should be considered by judges at all levels of competition

TMEA organization personnel should not distribute any region performance materials at any point under any conditions

## 8. MAC Report - Naida Ramsey

<u>Proposal</u>: Sub Non-varsity choirs sightread 3 lvs lower of varsity conference

Recommend a level down since currently Non-Varsity and Sub Non-Varsity read at the same level with only practice time difference

- Composers would need to write 3 more pieces, will probably not be able to make it work
- Not many schools taking Sub Non groups
- 3 levels down would essentially mean back to 8th grade Varsity and reading the same level two years in a row

In Favor: 0

Against: Unanimous

<u>Proposal</u>: Choirs performing a majority of unison music can have a unison sight reading option, if they perform two or more unison pieces in concert portion

- Same problem as before having to compose new pieces, perhaps use a two part (SA/TB) sight reading piece and they only read the melody, similar to procedure taken in COVID-19
